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Requirements for conference materials

- 1. Text design
- **1.1.** The text of the report must be typed in Ukrainian, Chinese or English. Ukrainian and Chinese texts must have an abstract in English. The text is typed in Times New Roman font (other as an addition, if necessary), 12 points font size, with one and a half intervals.
- 1.2. Page parameters: A4 format, margins of 15 mm on all sides. Pages must be numbered.
- 1.3. The text of the report should be no more than 7 pages A4.
- **1.4.** The text of the report at the beginning should contain: UDC (required for authors from Ukraine); title of the report in bold, 16 points; surname and initials of the author (authors); academic title, academic degree, position and affiliation (optional); city and country of residence (italics, 14 points); abstract in the language of the text; keywords; contact information: phone number, email (this information will not be published on the site). If you wish you can provide a translation of this information in both other Conference languages.
- **1.5.** Then after two blank lines the text of the report begins, which is printed in 12 points; titles of sections of the report and subheadings in bold, 14 points.
- **1.6.** The report should contain conclusions.
- **1.7.** The list of references is made out according to DSTU GOST 7.1.2006
- **2.** The received materials are checked for the possibility of their placement on our website. If the materials are accepted, a message will be sent to the author.
